- Queen Anne style reeded pattern cupboard door knobs made from solid brass with a dark brown, Florentine bronze finish.
- This popular design with its ringed pattern is ideal for use on classic or contemporary units including, kitchen cabinet doors, wardrobes, cupboard doors and drawers.
- With a ball shape knob and a stepped pattern detail these knobs are great for tying in with 1930's style Art Deco door handles and furniture.
- High architectural quality range, each knob is made from solid brass giving them a heavyluxuriousfeel.
- Two piece design, these knobs can be fitted with or with out the backplate rose.
- Florentine bronze finish, a dark brown colour which looks like aged tarnished brass.

Finish Details


- Florentine bronze a dark brown colour with golden highlights and visible brush marks in the surface. Florentine bronze is an applied finish used to give items an aged, tarnished look.
- Florentine bronze is a very good match to the antique brass finish.
- These items have been lacquered to help protect and maintain the finish.

Alternative Finishes Available

- Polished brass
- Polished chrome
- Satin chrome

Fixings

• This cupboard knob is fitted via a M4 bolt from the rear of the door / drawer - see below diagram.



- Bolt through fixings provide a superior strong fixing allowing this knob to be fitted to tall or heavy doors.
- Comes supplied with a 25mm long bolt suitable for use on 18mm thick doors.
- For doors thicker then 18mm, longer M4 fixing bolts are available to buy separately.(See related products below.)

Alternative Fixings

- For fixing two cupboard knobs back to back on either side of a door, a length of M4 stud is required to screw the two knobs together. See related products below.
- For face fixing a cupboard knob by screwing it directly into the front of a wooden door or drawer, a dual M4 / Wood screw is required. See related products below.

Usage

- Suitable for internal use.
- For doors thicker then 18mm please purchase longer M4 fixing bolts. (See related products below.)
